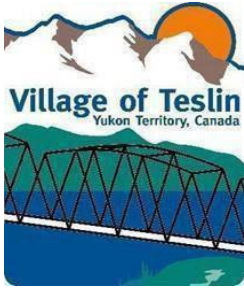

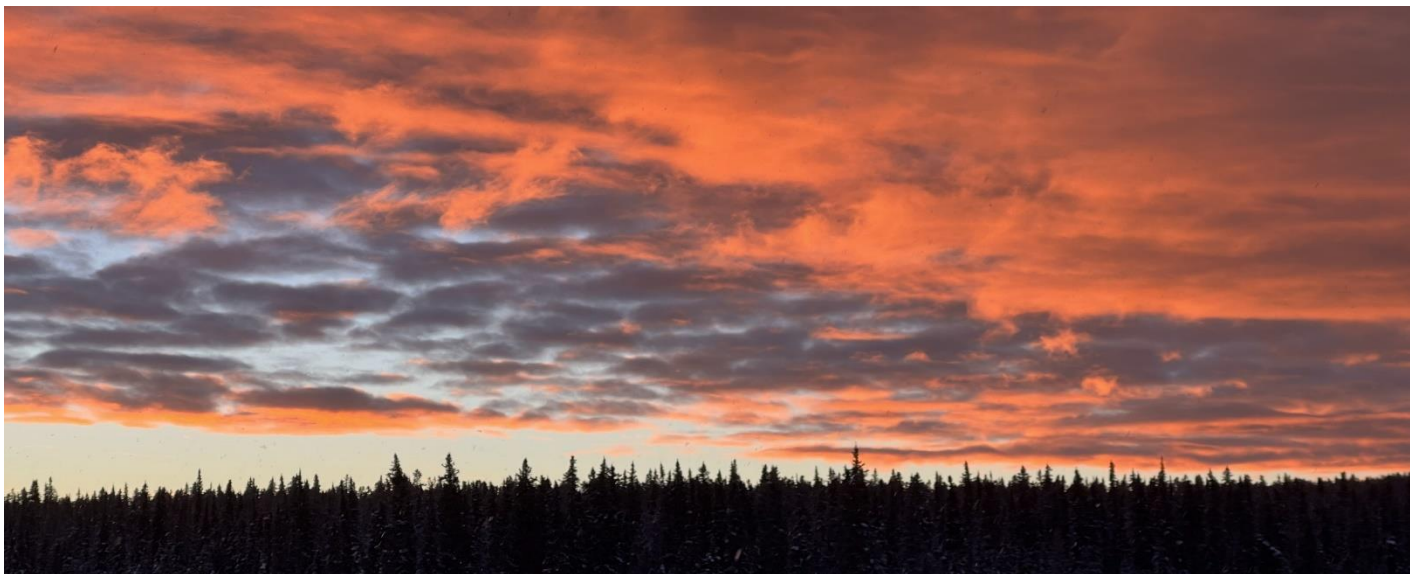

### **TESLIN ROADS**

Winter is here! Please be cautious driving and walking as conditions can be slippery. Snow removal equipment will be out and about, so be aware and give equipment space to work safely.

When removing

snow from your yard or driveways please do not push the snow into the roadway or ditch.

If there are any concerns with the road conditions, please call the office.

### **SOLID WASTE FACILITY/RECYCLING**

The solid waste facility hours are as follows:

Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday Closed to public

Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday – Noon to

6:00pm Saturday – 10:00 am to 5:00 pm

**Make sure you stop and see the attendant before dumping.**

There is no afterhours access to the facility so please plan accordingly.

Recycling bins need to be at the end of your driveway by 9am Wednesday mornings for pickup.

Please ensure there is no garbage in your recycling bins.

An average of one refuse bin a week is being sent to Whitehorse landfill for disposal. Everyone is encouraged to do recycling at home, and at work, to reduce the amount of material that goes to the landfill.

The Village of Teslin ten-year solid waste management plan is now complete and is submitted to YESAB for approval.

### **LAGOON AND SEWER SYSTEM**

All sewer lines are in good working order. Please be aware and careful of what is being flushed down the sewer system.

TKO Services (Khil Davies) is now providing pump-out services in Teslin please call 334-5636 to schedule your pump-out.

The Village of Teslin will be providing a temporary pump-out service for the community and surrounding area. Please phone TKO first for all pump-out requests as VOT is only providing these services as a last resort.

## **WATER QUALITY/ WATER DELIVERY**

The Water Treatment Plant (WTP) is in good working condition.

### **Please notify us if you will be away and not requiring water delivery.**

Kindly ensure that spouts & tank whistles are in good working order and lids are closed to help avoid water overflow.

Please ensure your driveways are clear and **accessible for the water truck** and the path to your fill spout is clear of snow, dog feces, and obstacles.

When constructing new buildings or renovating buildings please contact the Village office to get a copy of the water bylaw to ensure your water systems complies.

Please note that severe winter weather conditions may affect our water delivery service.

With the increasing demand for water delivery, schedules may be changed from time to time. Over the next few months Council will be reviewing the Water Bylaw and associated fees.

## **DOG CONTROL**

**The animal control bylaw is available on our website [www.teslin.ca](http://www.teslin.ca)**

Please ensure your pets are secure on your property. We take dog control very serious and are actively pursuing loose dogs, our public works staff do patrol for stray dogs 7 days a week and we are now patrolling in the evenings. If you have stray dogs wandering on your property, please call the Village office.

If you need materials to secure your dog on your property, let us know and we can provide it to you.

If your female dog is in heat, please keep them secure in your yard or home to help avoid dogs packing in groups.

**Once a dog is picked up by our staff, we notify the owner and if they are not picked up by the owner after three business days, they are sent to the animal shelter in Whitehorse.**

The Village of Teslin has partnered with Yukon Government & Humane Society on a dog surrender program, so if you need to surrender a dog, please give us a call and we can assist with making arrangements.

We are planning for future projects and we will be doing community consultation please respond as we really appreciate community feedback and your input is considered during decision making.

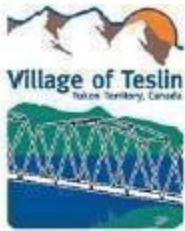
**The Village of Teslin has received COVID-19 Rapid tests to distribute to residents, if you need a test, please call the office.**

# Dogs Caught at Large in Teslin

Dogs running at large have been a constant dilemma for the community of Teslin. Increasing concern surrounding the potential of dogs packing up and posing potential risks to the public and other pets is growing. Yukon has been a victim of several dogs' at large accidents and incidents that may have been avoided if more care were taken to control dogs at large. Please be aware of the dangers that your dog can pose to others if it is allowed to roam at large in the community.

There are two programs sponsored by Yukon Government, Teslin Tlingit Council, and VOT to assist dog owners with the vet bill to have your dog spayed or neutered.

Dogs running at large (off their property and not with the owner) will be picked up by the Village of Teslin.

All dogs must be licensed with the Village of Teslin.



## Pound Fees

### 1<sup>st</sup> Offense:

- Licensed Dog - \$75.00
- Unlicensed Dog - \$75.00 plus the purchase of a license \$80.00
- Chain will be provided to owner for containment.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense:

- Dog will be taken to the animal shelter in Whitehorse to be re-homed.

**Youth Futsal** has started in Teslin thanks to volunteer coach Kevin Jajcaj. This skill development program runs on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:30-6:30 pm at the school gym. Our combined **Art & STEM** program had strong enough registration that we had to split the kids into 2 groups that will alternate weeks. Strong numbers for **After School Sports** have also led to the kids being split into different groups running Wednesday and Thursday. These programs are all Full.

**Basketball** continues on Friday nights, **Volleyball** on Saturdays, and now **Adult Futsal** has been added to Sundays starting in January. All these drop-in sports start at 7 pm at the school gym. A CASH PRIZE for the best soup, as voted on by the people, will be awarded Sunday. Tournament play will start Saturday morning and go later in the day this year thanks to lighting that will be set up by the **Graham** group. At the time of writing this, we have also had one local business step up with a cash donation to the event. Thank You **Thomas Electric** for your contribution towards the Lakespiel!! Let's plan to keep each other warm, fed, and having fun for another great, family-friendly weekend on the lake.

The **Parent & Tot Playgroup** has been taking place on Saturdays thanks to funding from RPAY and their RHEAL Leader program. A special **Clothing, Toy and Book Swap** will take place on February 11 in the arena lobby. Donations of gently used items of clothing, toys, or books for ages 0-3 will be accepted, cleaned, and ready to be given away at the swap.

We are teaming up with TTC Game Guardians, YG Conservation Officers, and the TRRC to run a **Youth Bison Hunt** in Champagne Aishihik First Nation territory this March. 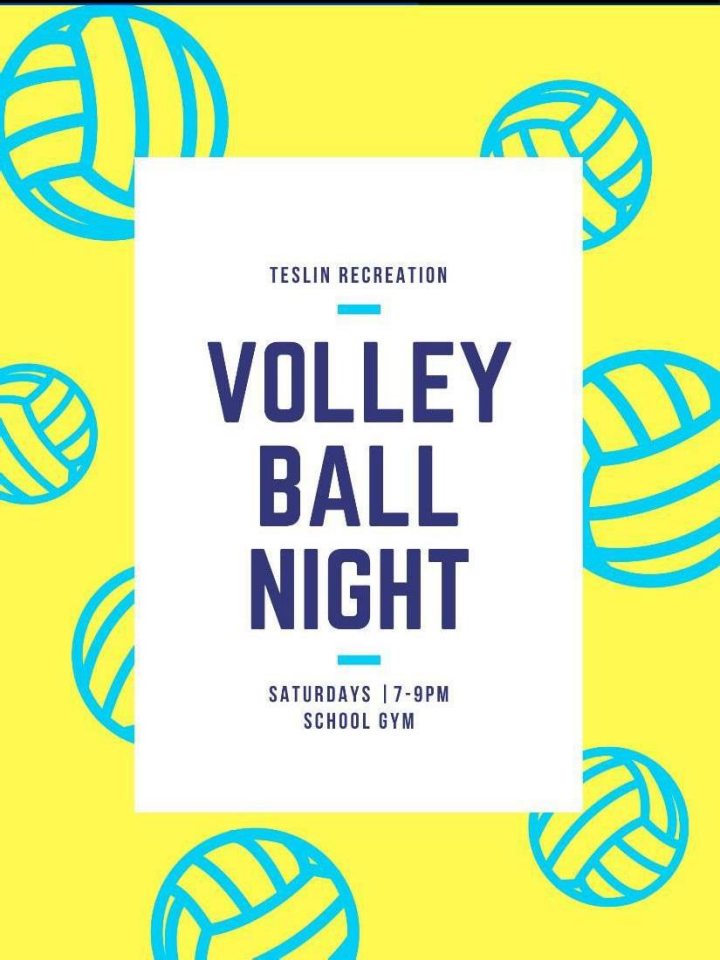

# CHICKEN & VEGGIE STIR-FRY

## Ingredients (for 6 servings)

- 1 lb chicken breast, cubed
- salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste
- 1 lb broccoli florets
- 8 oz mushroom, sliced
- 3 tablespoons oil, for frying

## SAUCE

- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tablespoon ginger, minced
- 2 teaspoons sesame oil
- ⅓ cup reduced sodium soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 1 cup chicken broth
- ¼ cup flour



## Instructions

1. In a large pan on medium-high heat, add 1 tablespoon of oil. Once the oil is hot, add chicken, season with salt and pepper, and sauté until cooked through and browned. Remove cooked chicken from pan and set aside.
2. In the same pan, heat 1 tablespoon of oil and add mushrooms. When the mushrooms start to soften, add broccoli florets and stir-fry until the broccoli is tender. Remove cooked mushrooms and broccoli from the pan and set aside.
3. Add 1 tablespoon of oil to the pan and sauté garlic and ginger until fragrant. Add the remaining sauce ingredients and stir until smooth.
4. Return the chicken and vegetables to the saucy pan, stir until heated through.
5. Serve with hot rice or noodles.



# HEALTHY BAKED BERRY CRISP

## Ingredients

### Berry Filling

- 5 cups berries (if frozen, drain of excess liquid)
- 1 Tbsp cornstarch
- 2 Tbsp sugar
- 1/4 tsp cinnamon

### Crumble Topping

- 1/2 cup old-fashioned oats
- 1/2 cup flour
- 2 Tbsp white sugar
- 2 Tbsp brown sugar
- 1/4 cup light butter, melted
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp vanilla extract



## Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 375 F.
2. Toss the berries with the corn starch, sugar and cinnamon.
3. Pour the berry mixture into a round pie or tart dish.
4. Combine the flour, oats, sugar, brown sugar, cinnamon, and vanilla extract in a mixing bowl.
5. Melt the butter and add it to the dry ingredients.
6. Stir to combine.
7. Using your fingers, sprinkle the crumble topping evenly on top of the berry mixture.
8. Bake for 40 minutes or until the berries are cooked down and bubbly, and the topping is browned to your liking.

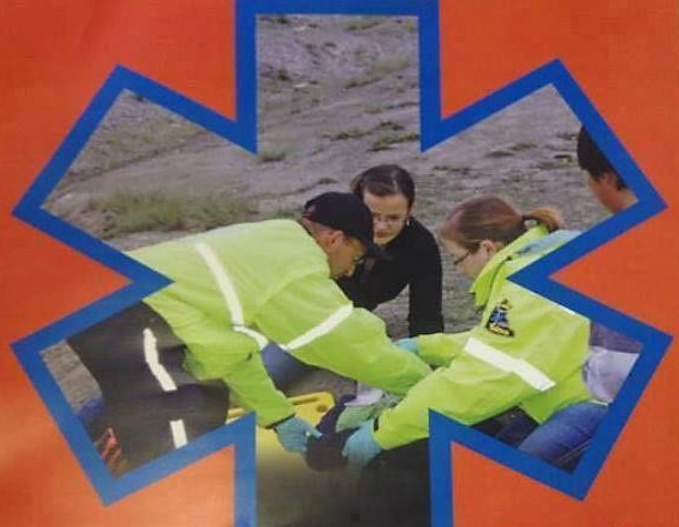

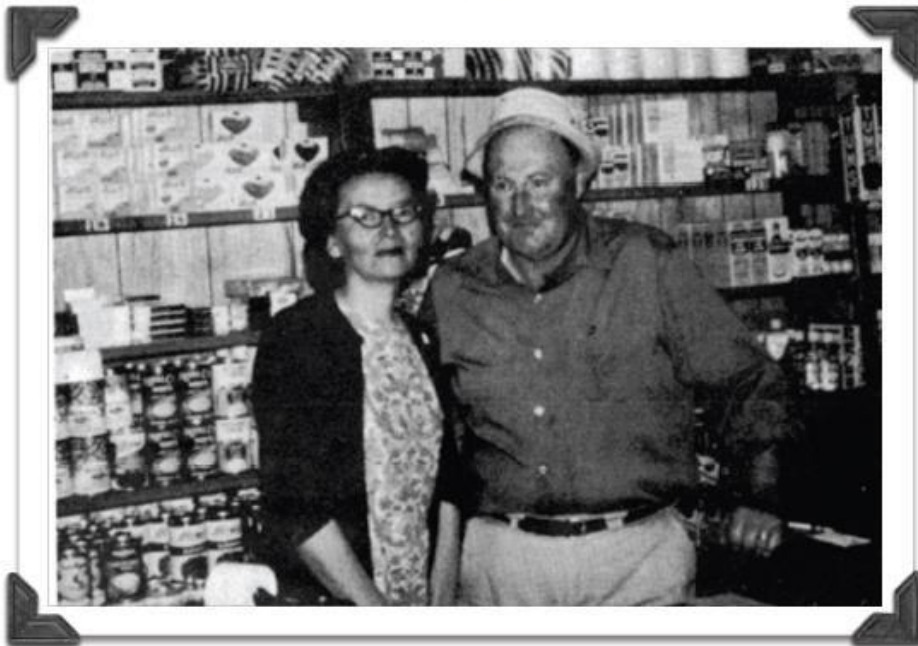
