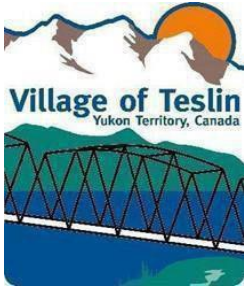

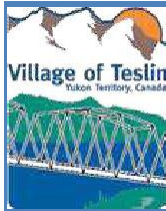

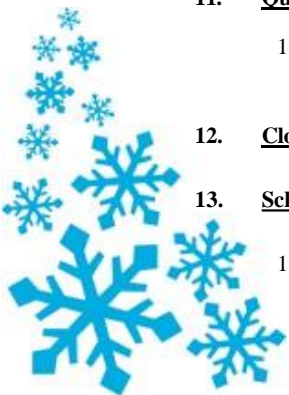

Administrative Report

December 2022

TESLIN ROADS

Winter is here! Please be cautious driving and walking as conditions can be slippery. Snow removal equipment will be out and about, so be aware and give equipment space to work safely.

SOLID WASTE FACILITY/RECYCLING

The solid waste facility hours are as follows:

Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday Closed to public

Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday – Noon to 6:00pm

Saturday – 10:00 am to 5:00 pm

Make sure you stop and see the attendant before dumping.

There is no afterhours access to the facility so please plan accordingly.

Recycling bins need to be at the end of your driveway by 9am Wednesday mornings for pickup. Please ensure there is no garbage in your recycling bins.

An average of one refuse bin a week is being sent to Whitehorse landfill for disposal. Everyone is encouraged to do recycling at home, and at work, to reduce the amount of material that goes to the landfill.

LAGOON AND SEWER SYSTEM

All sewer lines are in good working order. Please be aware and careful of what is being flushed down the sewer system.

TKO Services (Khiel Davies) is now providing pump-out services in Teslin please call 334-5636 to schedule your pump-out.

WATER QUALITY/WATER DELIVERY

The Water Treatment Plant (WTP) is in good working condition.

Please notify us if you will be away and not requiring water delivery.

Kindly ensure that spouts & tank whistles are in good working order and lids are closed to help avoid water overflow.



Please ensure your driveways are clear and **accessible for the water truck** and the path to your fill spout is clear of snow, dog feces, and obstacles.

When constructing new buildings or renovating buildings please contact the Village office to get a copy of the water bylaw to ensure your water systems complies.

Please note that severe winter weather conditions may affect our water delivery service.

With the increasing demand for water delivery, schedules may be changed from time to time.

Over the next few months Council will be reviewing the Water Bylaw and associated fees.

DOG CONTROL

The animal control bylaw is available on our website www.teslin.ca

Please ensure your pets are secure on your property. We take dog control very serious and are actively pursuing loose dogs, our public works staff do patrol for stray dogs 7 days a week and we are now patrolling in the evenings. If you have stray dogs wandering on your property, please call the Village office.

If you need materials to secure your dog on your property, let us know and we can provide it to you.

If your female dog is in heat, please keep them secure in your yard or home to help avoid dogs packing in groups.

Once a dog is picked up by our staff, we notify the owner and if they are not picked up by the owner after three business days, they are sent to the animal shelter in Whitehorse.

The Village of Teslin has partnered with Yukon Government & Humane Society on a dog surrender program, so if you need to surrender a dog, please give us a call and we can assist with making arrangements.

PROJECTS

The Fire department has moved into the new fire hall.

The tender for the energy upgrades to the municipal center has now closed and is under evaluation. The lighting & plumbing upgrades to the municipal center and Rec plex are now complete.

The equipment for the new playground in the Sawmill Road subdivision has arrived and installation will be completed in the spring.

FLOOD 2022

TTC and the Village of Teslin are seeking funding to complete permanent flood measures and are in the planning stages. Community consultation on permanent measures will be ongoing throughout the fall/winter.

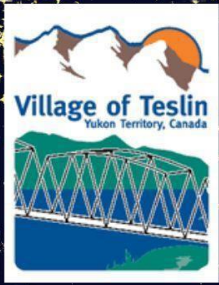
OTHER

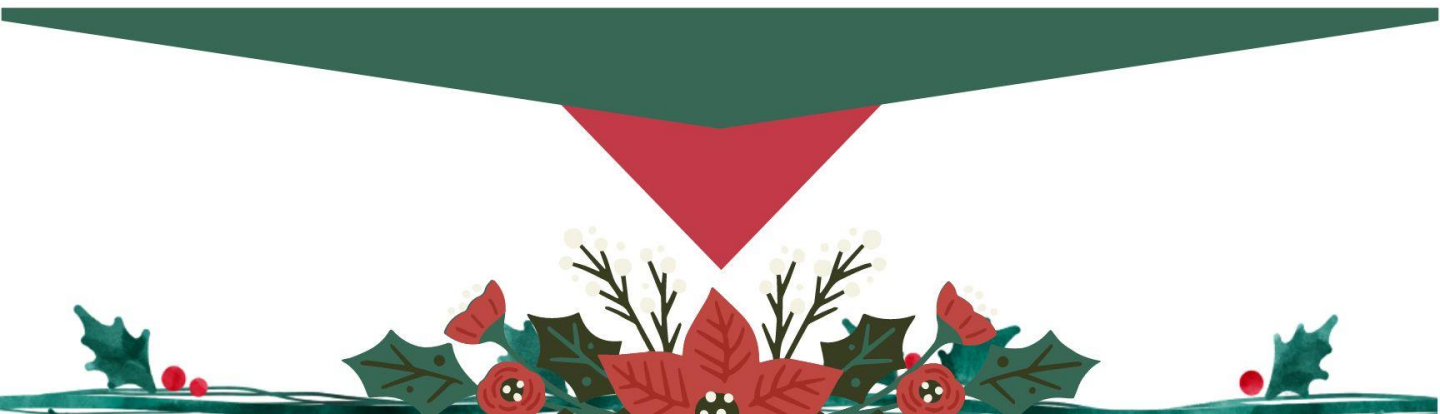

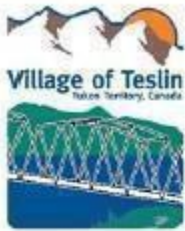

Dogs Caught at Large in Teslin

Dogs running at large have been a constant dilemma for the community of Teslin. Increasing concern surrounding the potential of dogs packing up and posing potential risks to the public and other pets is growing. Yukon has been a victim of several dogs' at large accidents and incidents that may have been avoided if more care were taken to control dogs at large. Please be aware of the dangers that your dog can pose to others if it is allowed to roam at large in the community.

There are two programs sponsored by Yukon Government, Teslin Tlingit Council, and VOT to assist dog owners with the vet bill to have your dog spayed or neutered.

Dogs running at large (off their property and not with the owner) will be picked up by the Village of Teslin.

All dogs must be licensed with the Village of Teslin.



Pound Fees

1st Offense:

- Licensed Dog - \$75.00
- Unlicensed Dog - \$75.00 plus the purchase of a license \$80.00
- Chain will be provided to owner for containment.

2nd Offense:

- Dog will be taken to the animal shelter in Whitehorse to be re-homed.

Also looking ahead to January, we will have our new Winter program schedule out. Some new additions include the return of the cross-country ski program under the new **Teslin Tiger Ski Club** name. Practices will run after school on Mondays starting January 9th and run until Spring Break. We will plan a trip in to Mount Mac at some point over the break too! A local volunteer is stepping up to run **Youth Futsal** on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:30-6:30pm at the school gym. We will combine **Art & STEM** into one after school program that will take place on Tuesdays, and **After School Sports** will move to Wednesdays and Thursdays with kids being split into different groups (1 per day). 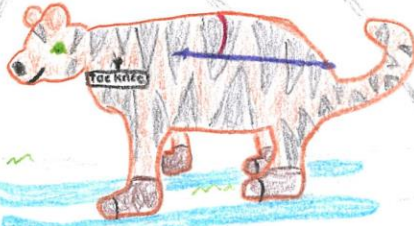

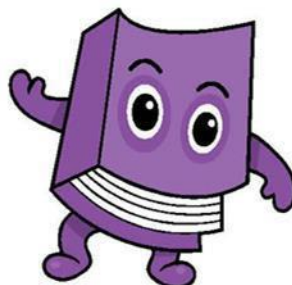

Slow Cooker Turkey Chili with Sweet Potatoes



Ingredients

- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 1 lb ground turkey
- 1 large yellow onion
- 1Tsp kosher salt
- 1 Tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 Tsp black pepper
- 1 Tbsp chili powder
- 2 Tsp chipotle chili powder
- 2 Tsp cumin
- 3 small sweet potatoes
- 1 cup uncooked quinoa
- 15 oz crushed tomatoes
- 15 oz black beans
- 4 1/2 cups chicken stock



Instructions

1. Heat the olive oil in a large skillet or Dutch oven over medium-high. Add the turkey, onion, salt, garlic powder, and black pepper. Cook and stir, breaking up the turkey as you go, until the turkey is no longer pink, about 5 minutes. Stir in the chili powder, chipotle chili powder, and cumin, then transfer to the bottom of a large slow cooker.
2. To the slow cooker, add the chopped sweet potatoes, quinoa, chicken stock, crushed tomatoes, and black beans. Cover and cook on high for 3-4 hours or low for 5-6 hours, until the potatoes are tender. Stir in additional chicken stock if the chili is thicker than you would like. Serve warm with desired toppings.

Banana Oat Pancakes



Ingredients

- 125ml oat milk
- 2 eggs, separated
- 1 small banana
- 100g rolled oats
- 2 tsp baking powder
- few drops of vanilla extract
- oil, we used avocado oil spray
- low-fat yogurt and fruit to top

Method

1. Put the oat milk, egg yolks, banana, oats, baking powder and vanilla in a blender and process to as smooth a mixture as you can get. Whisk the egg whites until they hold stiff peaks. Whisk 1-2 tbsp of the whites into the batter, then fold in the rest.
2. Heat a non-stick pan over medium heat and spray with a whisper of oil, pour about 2 tbsp of batter into the pan and cook for 1-2 mins, until the base sets and bubbles appear all over the top. Flip and cook the other side for a minute. Repeat in batches, making sure the top looks dryish before attempting the flip, or the center will collapse.

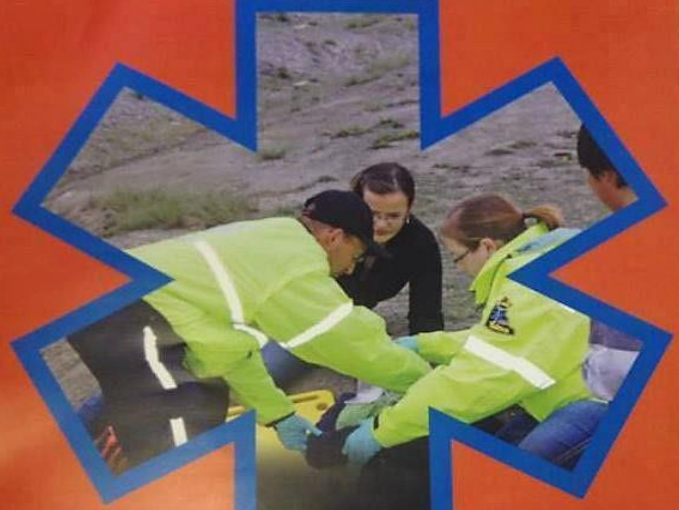
