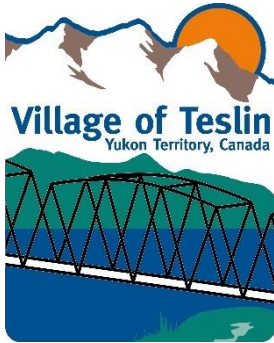



Some road maintenance items will be ongoing through the fall, in preparation for winter. Speed bumps will be removed for the winter season

SOLID WASTE FACILITY/RECYCLING

The solid waste facility hours are as follows:

Monday, Tuesday Closed to public

Wednesday–Thursday and Friday – Noon to 6:00pm

Saturday – 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

We are now accepting payment at the landfill.

There is no after hour access to the facility so please plan accordingly.

Recycling center is open to the public, though people are asked to count their own recycling.

Recycling bins need to be at the end of your driveway by 9am Wednesday mornings for pickup. Please ensure there is no garbage in your recycling bins.

An average of one refuse bin a week is being sent to Whitehorse landfill for disposal. Everyone is encouraged to do recycling at home, and at work, to reduce the amount of material that goes to the landfill.

LAGOON AND SEWER SYSTEM

All systems are in good working order. Please be aware and careful of what is being flushed down the system.

TKO Services (Khiel Davies) is now providing pump-out services in Teslin please call 334-5636 to schedule your pump-out.

WATER QUALITY/ WATER DELIVERY

The Water Treatment Plant (WTP) is in good working condition. Please notify us if you will be away and not requiring water delivery. Kindly ensure that spouts & tank whistles are in good working order and lids closed to help avoid water overflow.

When constructing new buildings or renovating buildings please contact the Village office to get a copy of the water bylaw to ensure your water systems complies.

Please note that severe winter weather conditions may affect our water delivery service.

Please ensure your driveways are clear and accessible for the water truck and ensure the driver can safely access your fill spout.

Due to the high water, YG Environmental Health is recommending that all water wells in the area be tested for bacteria. Sample bottles are available at the Village office.

DOG CONTROL

The animal control bylaw is available on our website www.teslin.ca

Please ensure your pets are secure on your property. We take dog control very serious and are actively pursuing loose dogs, our public works staff do patrol for stray dogs 7 days a week! If you have stray dogs wandering on your property, please call the Village office.

Once a dog is picked up by our staff, we notify the owner and if they are not picked up by the owner after three business days, they are sent to the animal shelter in Whitehorse.

The community dog spay program is still available. Please call the Village office for more information and to make arrangements to use this program.

September 2021 Recreation Report

We resumed a more regular schedule of after school programs in September. We continued to have a good turnout on Tuesdays for our **Young Explorers** program. We have enjoyed searching for birds, collecting rocks, exploring trails, identifying mushrooms and berries, and tending to the community garden during this program and will continue to run it as long as interest continues. We continued the **Youth Baseball** program through September, which will be replaced by **Archery** on Thursdays in October. We took advantage of dry pavement with **Bike Club** in September and will move indoors for **Public Skating** during the Friday after-school time slot in October. Wednesdays is **Pickleball** Day. We have added an after-school session and evening session from 7-8:30p, along with continuing to run the regular noon session. We are back in the main rec plex hall for pickleball for the winter.

The public works team got the **arena flooded** early this year and we are pretty excited about it. **Adult Hockey** will resume at the beginning of October and the **Minor Hockey** Season will kick off with a BBQ and award ceremony on Saturday, October 16; before regular practices resume on Tuesday evenings and Saturday afternoons. Nothing has been set for **Womens Hockey** this year, but if interest is there we will try and coordinate a time in conjunction with being able to help offer some childcare. We held a **Halloween Event Planning session** on Monday, Sept 13 to start working on plans and events for the community. We have a few ideas being thrown around to make this another awesome Halloween in Teslin. We are looking at Saturday, October 30 for the big event day- to include a 'Trunk-or-Treat', Haunted House, and Drive-In Movie. 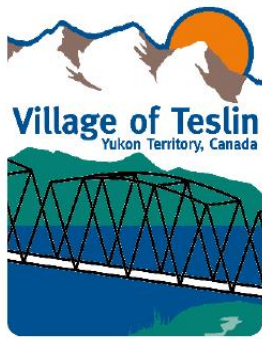

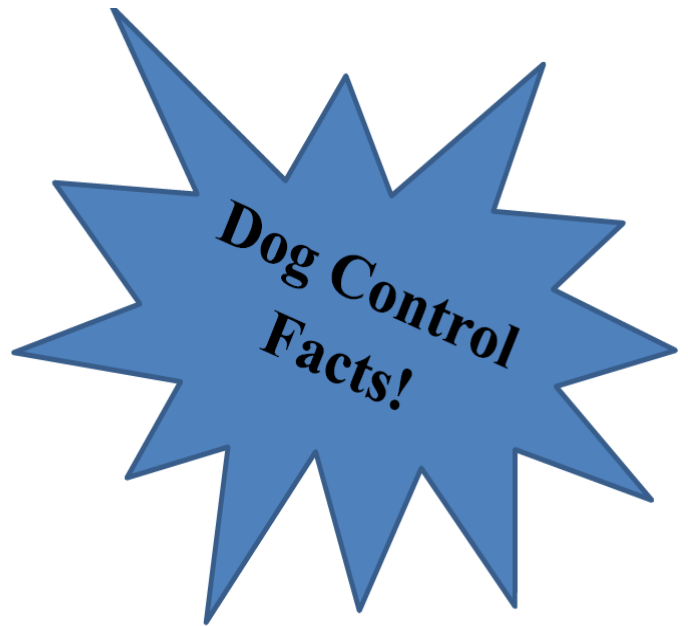

Applications are reviewed by a locally based committee and funding decisions are based on eligibility, merit and ability to meet fund criteria.



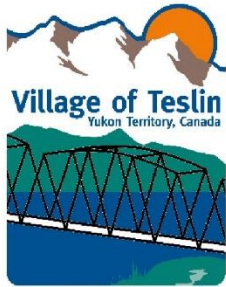
