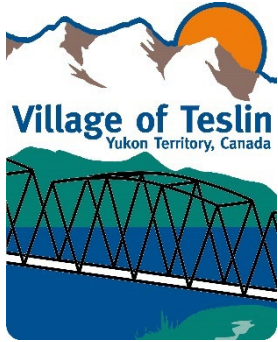

TESLIN ROADS

Jackson Ave is closed. Flood Crews continue to work in Teslin so please be cautious and watch for equipment working.

SOLID WASTE FACILITY/RECYCLING

The solid waste facility hours are as follows:

Monday, Tuesday Closed to public

Wednesday–Thursday and Friday – Noon to 6:00pm

Saturday – 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

Make sure you stop and see the attendant before dumping.

There is no after hour access to the facility so please plan accordingly.

Recycling center is open to the public, though people are asked to count their own recycling.

Recycling bins need to be at the end of your driveway by 9am Wednesday mornings for pickup. Please ensure there is no garbage in your recycling bins.

An average of one refuse bin a week is being sent to Whitehorse landfill for disposal. Everyone is encouraged to do recycling at home, and at work, to reduce the amount of material that goes to the landfill.

LAGOON AND SEWER SYSTEM

We are doing a discharge at the lagoon into the wetlands, this process will take 40 to 60 days.

All systems are in good working order. Please be aware and careful of what is being flushed down the system.

TKO Services (Khiel Davies) is now providing pump-out services in Teslin please call 334-5636 to schedule your pump-out.

WATER QUALITY/ WATER DELIVERY

The Water Treatment Plant (WTP) is in good working condition. Please notify us if you will be away and not requiring water delivery. Kindly ensure that spouts & tank whistles are in good working order and lids are closed to help avoid water overflow.

When constructing new buildings or renovating buildings please contact the Village office to get a copy of the water bylaw to ensure your water systems complies.

Please note that severe winter weather conditions may affect our water delivery service.

Please ensure your driveways are clear and **accessible for the water truck** and the path to your fill spout is clear of snow, dog feces and obstacles.

With the increasing demand for water delivery schedules may changed from time to time.

DOG CONTROL

The animal control bylaw is available on our website www.teslin.ca

Please ensure your pets are secure on your property. We take dog control very serious and are actively pursuing loose dogs, our public works staff do patrol for stray dogs 7 days a week and we are now patrolling in the evenings. If you have stray dogs wandering on your property, please call the Village office.

If you need materials to secure your dog on your property let us know and we can provide it to you.

If your female dog is in heat please keep them secure in your yard or home to help avoid dogs packing in groups.

Once a dog is picked up by our staff, we notify the owner and if they are not picked up by the owner after three business days, they are sent to the animal shelter in Whitehorse.

The community dog spay program is still available. Please call the Village office for more information and to make arrangements to use this program.

The Village of Teslin has partnered with Yukon Government & Humane Society on a dog surrender program, so if you need to surrender a dog, please give us a call and we can assist with making arrangements.

FLOOD 2022

The daily increase of lake rise has started to decrease, so going into July we will be monitoring berms and repairing as needed. We will also be monitoring pumps and keeping areas as dry as possible.

TTC and the Village of Teslin are seeking funding to complete permanent flood measures, but at the time writing we are still discussing with potential funders.

The Village of Teslin has received COVID-19 Rapid tests to distribute to residents, if you need a test, please call the office.

Village Council meetings have returned to the Council Chambers and the public is welcome to attend in person or via zoom. Council meetings will be reduced to one meeting per month for June, July & August and will be held the 2nd Monday of each month.

Swim Camp also didn't take place in June, but we are hoping that we can still pull off this amazing program later in the summer. Thanks to financial support from The Recreation and Parks Association of Yukon (RPAY) we are able to bring out certified lifeguard and instructor Willow Brewster to facilitate a unique program aimed at giving us the skills to safely enjoy the body of water where we live. The full week camp will run afternoons for ages 4-16. Our lifeguards will also lead a variety of special sessions throughout the week for all community members, including parents with tots, and those who want to learn basic lifesaving skills.

We have lined up some other great youth camps for the summer too! Many will recognize these from pre-covid years such as the **Elephant Thoughts Science Camp** taking place July 18-22 for youth 6-12 years old. Elephant Thoughts Camp can accommodate up to 25 kids and will include lunches and hoodies for all participants thanks to the kind sponsorship from the Electricity Human Resources Council. Yukon University will also be coming out July 11-14 to deliver a **STEM and Biking Camp** for youth aged 6-12. Please get signed up in advance.

Changes to Handling Dogs Caught at Large in Teslin



Dogs running at large have been a constant dilemma for the community of Teslin. Increasing concern surrounding the potential of dogs packing up and posing potential risks to the public and other pets is growing. Yukon has been a victim of several dogs' at large accidents and incidents that may have been avoided if more care were taken to control dogs at large. Please be aware of the dangers that your dog can pose to others if it is allowed to roam at large in the community.

There are two programs sponsored by Yukon Government, Teslin Tlingit Council, and VOT to assist dog owners with the vet bill to have your dog spayed or neutered.

Dogs running at large (off their property and not with the owner) will be picked up by the Village of Teslin.

All dogs must be licensed with the Village of Teslin.



Pound Fees

1st Offense:

- Licensed Dog - \$75.00
- Unlicensed Dog - \$75.00 plus the purchase of a license \$80.00
- Chain will be provided to owner for containment.

2nd Offense:

- Dog will be taken to the animal shelter in Whitehorse to be re-homed.
