10.3. OCP Update - Council Report Zoning Bylaw Flood Elevation.
Village Council directed staff to reword section 40.1 of the draft zoning bylaw as follows:
Development on land susceptible to a 1:100 year flood, as outlined on the Zoning Map, is restricted to those portions of the lot which fall outside of the flood risk zone, upless the applicant can demonstrate on

the Zoning Map, is restricted to those portions of the lot which fall outside of the flood risk zone, unless the applicant can demonstrate an acceptable method of flood proofing the proposed development and complete the flood hazard waiver Schedule F.

Council also directed staff to seek further information and legal advice.
